## Teacher Information FAQs

### Cost

- \$6/ Student or Adult
- 1 teacher FREE/ per 25 students

\*Minimum of 10 students or flat rate of \$60 for tour\*

### Payment

- Payments accepted: Cash, Check, Mastercard, VISA, Discover
- Must receive payment before/upon arrival
- There will be no refund for number of guests less than specified on final confirmation.
- There will be a \$35 fee for all returned checks.

### Scheduling/ Rescheduling/ Cancellation

- Teachers will receive a confirmation email once the day and time of the tour has been scheduled.
- A confirmation/reminder email will be sent several days prior to the planned tour to confirm the number of attendees.
- Please call or email 48 hrs prior to your original scheduled tour to cancel or reschedule
- There will be a \$XX fee for all no shows
- Rain Policy: We don't let the weather keep us from learning! We plan on having a great time rain or shine.... The only exception would be lightning.

### Arrival

- Please arrive 15 mins prior to your scheduled tour time to allow time to check-in.
- We will not allow time extensions to groups that are more than 15 mins late.
- Please have your group divided before you arrive. We can fit a maximum of XX per hayride/demonstration.

- Please dress accordingly! All activities take place outdoors, the weather will not stop us from having a great time.
